Entry Form	Please use an official entry form (with all contact info given) FOR EVERY HORSE/RIDER Combination.										
Numbers	(Computer numbers) are to go on your entry form and horse numbers only are to be worn. If your horse does not have a number please see the secretary on the morning of the show for a day number (you will not be able to enter the ring without a number).										
Late Entries	Will be accepted at \$10 per class and this does include day entries. Entries that are not accompanied by an entry fee will not be accepted.										

CLASS DEFINITION & INFORMATION

HALTER CLASSES - Appaloosa and Quarter Horse Halter Classes will be run in accordance with the APHANZ & NZQHA rule books. Horses entered in the Appaloosa, Paint or Quarter Horse sections must be registered with their respective Associations & owners must be current financial members. Registration papers are to be carried. **There will be no “pending” of registration papers for horses over 2 years of age.**

If there are six or less halter entries for the show the minimum mandatory events will be held.

GRADE HORSE - Any breed of horse that is not a Reg. Quarter Horse, Reg. Paint Horse or Reg. Appaloosa may enter Grade Horse classes.

PERFORMANCE CLASSES - Will be run in accordance with the NZWRF rule book.

CHILDREN'S CLASSES - Children may enter Lead Line **OR** Walk Trot classes, not both. Children entering the Lead Line or Walk Trot classes may not enter other ridden classes. These classes may be ridden in English or Western Tack & Attire.

LEAD LINE - Horses must be lead by an adult over 18 years of age. A lead rope of at least 2 m long must be attached to the shank of the bit or a halter that is under the bridle.

AMATEUR - Competitors must hold a current NZWRF Amateur Card which must be carried and shown to gate steward or a copy sent to the show secretary with entries. **NO CARD – NO ENTRY.**

ROOKIE RIDER - Any rider who has not won an open or age division class in any of the three designated Rookie classes as at 1st August 1990, or has not earned an accumulation overall of 30 Rookie points in Rookie classes. Those eligible to ride in Rookie classes may ride a horse of any age two handed in a snaffle bit or hackamore but must use one hand if using a curb bit.

JUNIOR HORSE - Horse to be five years & under, to be ridden in a snaffle bit or hackamore with two hands.

SENIOR HORSE - Horse to be six years & over and to be ridden in tack according to Rule Q443H of the AQHA Rule Book.

YOUTH - Junior Youth 13 years & under. Senior Youth 14 - 18 years. As at 1st August.

BEGINNER SHOWMANSHIP – (NP) Any beginner that has not won any showmanship class more than twice is eligible to enter. Western tack & attire essential.

ARRIVAL ON THE GOUNDS – please complete your arrival / hay information and return it to the show Secretary on when you intend to arrive on the grounds so all facilities and yards are available for your use.

Please do not bring your horse/s to our show or grounds if it's shows any signs of carrying any infectious or contagious disease –ie influenza, strangles, warts, cough - of any sort. Or you will be asked to leave. This is not personal. Thanks for your cooperation.
